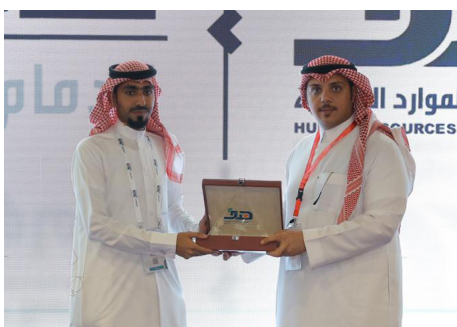


Asharqia Young Businesswomen Council Visit SPSP
